Introduction - Soprano Solo

O, all ye who travel upon the highway, hearken to me, and behold me; was e'er sorrow like unto my sorrow? For the Lord Almighty hath dealt bitterly with me. Call me now no more Naomi, from today call me Mara.

First Word - Baritone and Tenor Soli with Chorus

Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.

And the people clamored: He is death-guilty; take him, take him, let us crucify him! Be his blood on us, and on our children! Then they did crucify Jesus, and the two thieves, one at His right hand, the other at His left hand.
