Summer is here, what a wonderful relief! And as the Covid pandemic subsides, we are able to consider the gradual return to normal activities. We have been worshipping in-person since mid-March, taking precautions, distancing, wearing masks. There have been few other meetings.

With the rescinding of Covid mandates by the governor on June 2, and considering the decline in cases, hospitalizations, and deaths, and the vaccination rate, and in consultation with the deacons and other church leaders, we believe it is safe to relax some of the protocols, particularly mask-wearing. So on the first Sunday in June, the wearing of masks will be optional.

In the coming months the worship service will be expanded a little, and other meetings can resume as it is fitting. All this will be organic, meaning there is no definite



schedule. As things come up, we will decide to go ahead with normal activities, always considering whatever the present situation may be. I want to be sure that anyone who wants to wear a mask is encouraged and welcome to do so. I thank everyone for your patience and cooperation this past year. It has been hard, and you have been very faithful.

I also want to talk about membership. We have been blessed with new friends as we are coming out of this Covid year. Because we weren't meeting and then in restricted ways, we haven't really spoken about formalizing these new relationships. There are several bases on which one can join our fellowship:

- 1 - By profession of faith and baptism
- 2 - By a transfer from a sister Baptist congregation
- 3 - By a statement of faith from other Christian faith traditions

I am mindful that some who wish to be a part of the FBC family life may not be interested in formal membership. Please don't feel any pressure. For those who are interested, mention it to me and I will be happy to answer any questions you may have. Then in a worship service where there can be a formal affirmation, we will present your decision to join.
